### ABOUT 8MBA: WHAT WE DO

- Founded in 1993 to revitalize and promote the Eight Mile corridor by linking the public and private sectors
- Funded by Government Dues (50%), Private Grants and Sponsorships (50%)
- Eight Mile's primary champion: a change agent, a fundraiser, and a conduit for collaboration.
  - Facilitating collaboration between stakeholders, aligning agendas
    - Linking stakeholders with resources, fundraising
    - Leveraging Eight Mile as common ground for shared impact
      - Championing Eight Mile as a priority in each community
        - Supporting Eight Mile neighborhoods and businesses
      - Initiating projects and programs to revitalize Eight Mile
  - Advancing the projects and programs of our stakeholders on Eight Mile

### 8MBA IMPACT: CORE PROGRAMS



### **FAÇADE IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM**

- Up to \$10K for property owners to renovate Eight Mile properties
- Design & Permitting assistance
- 24 projects since 2008 (more than 3 per year)
- Average return on investment of approx. \$3 for every \$1 granted



#### **CLEAN TEAM CAMPAIGN**

- Corridor-wide beautification and blight removal projects
- Unites urban & suburban partners
- Over 20K volunteer hours to-date
- Tool rental program launched April 2015- approx. 2 dozen cleanups supported already



#### LEADERSHIP LUNCHEON

- Annual fundraiser in its 17<sup>th</sup> year
- Approx. 700 guests per year
- Raises 30% of annual budget

### **ACCOMPLISHMENTS**

Knudsen Park - \$100K Investment; public and private grant sources

Leadership Luncheon – 5-year revenue high (\$98K raised)

Installed: Detroit-Warren Conner Creek Greenway Crossing (\$500K)

2 Façade Improvement Projects (\$15K grants = \$40K private investment)

\$50K MEDC Grant secured for façade improvement/blight removal

Over \$200K in grants and sponsorships raised for Eight Mile

Requested Action:

#### Background:

The Department of Public Works classifies alley's in three categories:

- 1) Commercial Alleys: All commercial alleys have been paved, snow is plowed in the winter and cold patched as needed.
- 2) Improved Residential Alleys: Residents have contributed to the cost for the alley to be paved and snow is plowed in the winter, no cold patch has been needed as of this time.
- 3) Un-improved Residential Alley's: Existing alley's which are gravel or badly deteriorated asphalt. No maintenance is done on this type of alley.

Recently there has been a request to perform maintenance on an existing un-improved alley on the south side of Oakland Street between Wilmarth Street and Picket Street.


