Agenda Topic: Appointment to Planning Commission		
<p>Proposed Motion: Move to appoint _____ to serve a 3-year term on the Farmington Planning Commission, term ending June 30, 2022.</p>		
<p>Background: There is a vacancy on the Planning Commission left by Kenneth Chiara who served for nearly 10 years.</p> <p>The City is also seeking a resident to fill vacancy on the Board of Review for a term ending 12/31/2020. This vacancy might be an option for one of the Planning Commission candidates. There are no applicants for the Board of Review at this time.</p> <p>The Board of Review is established pursuant to the General Property Tax Act of Michigan. The primary function of the Board of Review is to review the assessment roll prepared by the Assessor, to hear appeals from property owners regarding their assessments, to consider poverty exemptions, and to make corrections regarding names and homestead exemptions. The City of Farmington contracts with the Oakland County Equalization Department for Assessor Services.</p> <p>The Board of Review schedules a number of meetings each March to hear appeals regarding the assessment roll prepared by the Assessor. In addition, they hold a meeting in June and December to make technical corrections to the assessment roll.</p>
