### SUMMARY OF NOTABLE INCIDENTS

#### FLEE AND ELUDE:

On 07/05/2024 at 1930 hours an officer observed a motorcycle E/B Grand River and Farmington Road with no plate. The officer attempted to initiate a traffic stop at Grand River and Warner. The motorcycle fled E/B on Grand River passing slower traffic left of center and accelerating. Due to heavy pedestrian traffic in the downtown area, the officer did not pursue the motorcycle. The motorcycle was described as red/black sports-bike style motorcycle. The case was forwarded to the detective bureau for further investigation.

#### RESISTING OFFICER/HIT AND RUN PDA:

On 07/04/2024 officers were dispatched to the area of Farmington Road south of Nine Mile for a suspicious vehicle. Dispatch advised the vehicle struck another vehicle as it quickly left the area when confronted by the reporting party. Officers observed the vehicle leaving the area and conducted a traffic stop at Farmington Road and Stocker. The 22-year-old male driver refused officers orders to exit the vehicle. Officers used minimal force in removing the driver. The driver was subsequently issued a citation for Resisting an Officer and leaving the scene of a private property damage accident.

#### LARCENY:

On 07/01/2024 a tenant who resides at the Chatham Hills Apartment complex reported money and gold stolen from her apartment unit between 06/30/2024 and 07/01/2024. The tenant reported that maintenance did some repairs to her unit on 07/01/2024 and may have knowledge of the theft. A check of the maintenance records during that time revealed no unannounced entries by maintenance during that time.
