Agenda Topic: Appointments to the Construction Board of Appeals

Proposed Motion:

Move to appoint Ron Pennington, Tim Waker and John Perry to the Farmington Construction Board of Appeals for 2-year terms ending February 28, 2020; and appoint Joe Schornack as an alternate, term ending 2020.

Background:

The Construction Board is a 5-member board; its members serve 2-year terms. There are currently three vacancies on the board, as well as an opening for an alternate.

State of Michigan code requires that municipalities have a Construction Board of Appeals seated to review appeals to code-related issues. Appeals are contractor/permit holder requested based on one of the following:

- 1. Inspector interpretation is incorrect;
- 2. The code does not apply;
- 3. There is an equal or better form of construction.

Decisions of this board maybe appealed to the State of Michigan construction code commission in accordance with the act and time frames.

The board of appeals shall consist of members who are qualitied in accordance with the act and are not employees of the governmental subdivision or the agency enforcing the code.

In the past 30 years, the construction board has met about three times and those appeals where more than 25 years ago.

Farmington Code Official, John Koncsol, recommends the following appointment to the commission:

Ron Pennington: Pennington is the current construction superintendent for Braun Construction. He is a resident of Milford.

Tim Waker: Waker is the chief engineering inspector for the City of Farmington Hills. He is also a Milford resident

John Perry: Perry currently serves on the Downtown Public Parking Committee and works for Levy Company; he has dedicated 31 years to the construction business; and is a civil engineer. He lives in the City of Farmington.

Joe Schornack: Schornack is past public safety officer/fire marshal for the City of Farmington, he is the recently retired Commerce Township Fire Chief. He is a Farmington resident.
